INTRODUCTION

Aim:

- To determine staff awareness health effects of smoking
- 2. To determine attitudes towards the implementation of a smoke-free campus prior to implementation

METHODS

Setting: A private college that provides secondary and tertiary education to students over 11 years old

Sample: 219 employees at the college including faculty and staff

Online survey in 2018 on:


- Demographics: Age, gender, smoking status,
- Health effects of active and passive smoking
- Attitudes towards the smoking ban law

All results presented as percentage of the total sample.


RESULTS

Demographics

Gender: 33% male and 67% female




Graph 1. College employees by age groups




Graph 2. College employees by smoking status

Smokers


10% of smokers were 20-29 years old and 82% were 35-59 years old



Graph 3. Daily cigarette consumption of Regular smokers




Attitudes and Awareness

CONCLUSION

- Smoking prevalence among staff was lower than the Greek public reported in 2017¹ with high percentage of ex-smokers
- Smokers: Low consumption, intention to quit
- All college employees were highly aware of health effects of smoking and were supportive towards the implementation of a smoke-free campus.
